

Social and Economic Development



THE HISTORY OF YEARS OF CULTURE

Years of Culture was launched in 2012 after Qatar won the bid to host the FIFA World Cup™ 2022. Part of the preparations for this event focused on generating deeper mutual understanding and stronger connections between nations through cultural exchange, laying the groundwork for closer ties ahead of the first-ever football World Cup in the Arab region.



COUNTRY PARTNERS

Initial country partners were those that previously hosted the World Cup or were scheduled to host it. Following the successful FIFA World Cup Qatar 2022™, Years of Culture expanded its partnerships to countries with which Qatar has established strong relations.























Qatar International Food Festival

The Festival is a Visit Qatar initiative celebrating Qatar's diverse food, beverage, and hospitality offerings. Year of Culture partner countries can participate as guests of honour, hosting popular chefs and offering visitors a chance to sample traditional cuisine.

QATAR MUSEUMS



JEDARIART murals on the Olympic Cycling Track

In partnership with Ashghal (Qatar's public works authority), artists from Years of Culture partner countries are invited to design a mural for an underpass of the Qatar Olympic Cycling Track.



Photography Journey

The Photography Journey is an exchange programme allowing photographers from Qatar and the partner country to capture images inspired by each year's chosen theme under the guidance of expert mentors.



Night at the Museum community events

Cultural sites around Qatar are encouraged to host Night at the Museum community engagement events inspired by Years of Culture partner countries, consisting of musical, culinary, and other entertainment for visitors of all ages.

QATAR NATIONAL LIBRARY



Qatar National Library's Family Reading Programme

Qatar Reads donates 1,000 specially curated reading packages to community libraries in partner countries. Kids in Qatar also receive packages featuring books inspired by the partner country. Each package includes two books, comics, and activity sheets, offering different ways of enhancing reading skills. The Family Reading Program, part of Qatar National Library's Qatar Reads effort, is aimed at children aged 3 to 13 and encourages a love for books.

Doha Film Institute's Years of Culture film screenings and Cinema Under the Stars events


The Doha Film Institute works with partner countries to select a series of films that can be screened in Qatar for attendees of all ages during different parts of the year.

The Education City Speaker Series is a global platform for dialogue that gathers experts and thought leaders to discuss key issues and trends shaping the world.





QATAR MUSEUMS



JEDARIART mural programme

JEDARIART aims to showcase works by Qatari and Qatari-based artists in public spaces and often collaborates with Years of Culture partner countries to create murals.



Photography Journey

The Photography Journey sends two photographers from Qatar to the partner country to capture its beauty, culture, and history. Photographers from the partner country also travel to Qatar.



CultuRide

The cycling tour through Qatar's partner country allows participating riders to meet local communities and interact face-to-face, allowing for an immersive cultural experience that leads to life-long friendships.



Qatar Museums' Professional Volunteer Trip

Qatar Museums' Community Service Section organises an international volunteer trip to work with local schools and social development organisations on skills-based workshops, including photography, marketing, and others.
